The 2023 Business Plan of Golden State Finance Authority (GSFA) serves as a guiding document for the organization, directing efforts and resources, in accordance with its mission, across three main areas:

Affordable Housing Solutions:

Advancing homeownership through the provision of affordable housing solutions

- Increase racial equity through homeownership with a targeted outreach campaign regarding down payment assistance programs
- Research and identify strategies and partnerships to assist rural counties seeking to facilitate affordable and workforce housing development
- Explore the implementation of new financial assistance programs to expand homeownership

Affordable Energy Financing:

Providing affordable options for homeowners and developers to obtain energy efficiency financing

- Increase utilization of commercial energy programs
- Continue to evaluate opportunities in the provision of residential energy programs
- Explore methods to increase funding for the Advanced Rebate Payment (ARP) program

Infrastructure Financing:

Promoting economic development in rural communities with infrastructure financing supports

- Support the deployment of open-access high-speed municipal broadband in rural California
- Explore opportunities and increased funding for the grant lending program to expand assistance options for county infrastructure projects
- Pursue regional grant opportunities to assist rural counties in obtaining infrastructure investments

Our Story (1993 to Present)

- Assisted more than 84,900 individuals or families to purchase or refinance homes
- Provided more than \$654.5 Million in down payment assistance
- Participated in over **\$15.6 Billion** in loan financing of first and second mortgages
- Issued **\$2.7 billion** in tax exempt and taxable mortgage revenue bonds
- Participated in financing of 36,100 residential and commercial energy efficiency projects
- Participated in over \$1 Billion in energy efficiency financing.
- Provided \$10 Million investment in California forest resiliency initiative
- Attained \$2.75 Million in broadband grant funding for rural California counties
- Partnered with the CA Fire Foundation, providing \$50,000 in wildfire relief funding to rural county communities
- Provided over \$3.5 Million in emergency disaster assistance to address the impact of forest fires on California residents
