# Flood-Impacted Families May Qualify for Up to \$300,000 — Free Workshop in Santa Cruz County

Program offers forgivable loans to help Californians affected by the 2023 floods buy safer homes

**Santa Cruz County, CA, October 1, 2025** – Golden State Finance Authority (GSFA) invites individuals and families that were living in Santa Cruz County during the 2023 floods to attend a free Homebuyer Workshop on Monday, October 20, 2025, from 7:00 – 8:00 p.m. at the Downtown Boulder Creek Rec Center, Gymnasium.

The workshop will introduce the ReCoverCA Homebuyer Assistance (HBA) Program, which offers up to \$300,000 in forgivable home loan assistance for eligible renters and former homeowners affected by recent California floods. The program helps low- to moderate-income households purchase homes in lower-risk areas of the state, specifically outside designated special flood hazard zones and high fire-risk areas.

#### Attendees will learn about:

- How the ReCoverCA HBA Program works
- Eligibility requirements
- Qualifying property types
- Steps to get started

The event also offers an optional networking session with GSFA representatives and approved ReCoverCA HBA Lenders after the main presentation, giving participants the opportunity to ask questions, gather resources, and set up follow-up appointments for personalized support.
